the seams any time. We just don't know how much more it can take. Finally we are looking to get some relief here with the pressure easing off. However, because this aspect is in it's last moments, it is not without some possible final fireworks. We never should take our eyes off Uranus for long; that planet of sudden and unexpected events.
